THE FY2024-25 PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BELLVILLE WILL RAISE MORE REVENUE FROM TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY AN AMOUNT OF \$27,677, WHICH IS A 1.75 PERCENT INCREASE FROM LAST YEAR'S BUDGET. THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE TO BE RAISED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL THIS YEAR IS \$48,840.
