5. CONSIDERATION/DISCUSSION OF SPECIAL PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF BELLVILLE

Sewer Project – Estimated cost \$491,240.00 The motion was made by Alderman Lottridge and seconded by Alderman Browning to proceed with this project. Motion carried unanimously.

Street Project – Estimated cost \$1,022,937.00 The motion was made by Alderman Lynn and seconded by Alderman Lottridge to proceed with this project. Motion carried unanimously.

Clark Park Project – Estimated cost \$1,429,000.00 Alderwoman Kistler made the motion to proceed with this project and then later withdrew her motion. Council agreed to table this item until 11/13/07. Library Project – Estimated cost \$867,438.00 Council agreed to table this item.
