1. 8 A.M. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Joe Ed Lynn called the meeting to order at 8:03 a.m.

2. INVOCATION AND PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE

Alderman Wayne Browning led all in prayer and Pledges of Allegiance.

4. CONSIDERATION TO ADOPT AGENDA

The motion was made by Alderman Lottridge and seconded by Alderman Harrison to adopt the Agenda for the Special Meeting of March 24, 2018 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

6. DISCUSSION REGARDING FINANCIAL SERVICES

7. DISCUSSION REGARDING GENERAL REVENUE

Cathy Ezell presented the Proposed Changes to the General Fund Revenues. She explained the City is currently charging for some items but it is not found in the City Ordinances. The Fee Schedule needs to be updated.

8. DISCUSSION REGARDING REVENUE VS EXPENSES

Discussion was held regarding the City's Revenue and Expenses by department. Cathy Ezell presented to Council comparisons for the past 5 years.

9. DISCUSSION REGARDING GAS RATES
