

ATTENTION CITY OF BELLVILLE RESIDENTS

The Water Service Line Notice included with your utility bills is a requirement from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). This notice aims to inform you that the City of Bellville does not currently know the type of service line that connects your residence or business to the water meter.

If your property was constructed after July 1, 1998, it is unlikely to have a lead service line, as Texas banned lead lines at that time. However, properties built before this date may still have lead or galvanized lines, although this is not guaranteed.

If you discover that your service line is made of lead or galvanized material, we recommend replacing it with PVC or PEX piping at your earliest convenience. Additionally, TCEQ requires the City to test our water system for lead and other heavy metals annually, ensuring that our public drinking water meets both federal and state safety standards. We are proud to report that the City of Bellville's water system has received a Superior rating from TCEQ. This designation is the highest possible for a public water system in Texas, indicating that we consistently meet and exceed the state and federal standards for drinking water safety, reliability, and quality.
