

**PUBLIC NOTICE  
SPRING CLEAN-UP  
FREE ACCESS TO RECYCLING CENTER**

The City of Bellville is again providing a designated Spring Clean-Up Service from **Monday, March 13, 2023 through Saturday, March 18, 2023**. This service is provided for the benefit of the City's residents and promotion of the beautification of our City. **Citizens will have free access to the Recycling Center in lieu of a curbside pick-up.** This service is for **INSIDE CITY LIMIT RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMERS ONLY. NO COMMERCIAL GARBAGE WILL BE ALLOWED!**

The following requirements must be followed when items are brought to the Recycling Center.

1. Items of different types **MUST** be separated, i.e. aluminum cans, glass, metal, plastic, cardboard, wood, etc. **ANY REFUSE NOT SEPARATED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!!!!!!**
  - Shredded paper and office paper should be separated from newspapers/magazines
  - Glass to be separated by color – clear separated from dark & green
  - Plastic should be separated as follows:
    - #1 Clear (water bottles, soda bottles)
    - #2 HDPE High Density Polyurethane (detergent bottles)
    - #2 Clear (milk jugs)
2. Appliances that use freon will not be accepted unless the freon has been removed by an authorized dealer and proof is presented.
3. If any resident has MORE than a THREE (3) CUBIC YARD TRUCK LOAD of debris, THERE WILL BE A \$25.00 CHARGE.
4. No hazardous waste of any kind will be accepted - i.e. paint cans, insecticides, tires, etc.

**ANY ITEMS NOT MEETING THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**

Citizens may bring items meeting the above requirements to the Bellville Recycling Center at 600 West Nichols Street during the above period at no charge upon presentation of a City utility bill stub. Recycling Center hours are M-F 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Any questions, please contact City Hall at 865-3136.
